POWER BREAKING

- List and Track
- Only the foot can make contact to break
- Must designate the number of boards to be attempted to judge prior to competition starting.
- Single attempt then it goes to next competitor.
- No changes to board designation allowed after declaration.
- In case of Tie, lighter competitor wins or the competitor that attempted more
- Any side kick EXCEPT a flying side kick may be used (only one step)

CREATIVE BREAKING

- List and track results (collaboration for results)
- 3 Stations Max (a station is defined by an individual break with hand or foot, or breaking simultaneously while in the air)
- 3 attempts in max at each station. Be more lenient with tigers and color belts.
- Touching the board for measuring does not constitute an attempt.
- Unlimited number of boards
- Board sizes at discretion of competitor
- Head break is not allowed.
- Competitor should declare breaks then be granted permission to break.
- Competitor should have their own holders

 Judging Criteria: number of attempts, level of difficulty, number of stations, technique & balance

HIGH JUMP BREAKING

- List and track results (collaboration for results)
- 3 Attempts Max to get the highest score
- Must land on feet
- Single attempt then it goes to next competitor.
- Jump front kick is the technique use with max 12' running start (4 square mats)
- Touching the board for measuring does not constitute an attempt.
- In case of a Tie, the shorter competitor wins
- Judging Criteria: highest score within 3 attempts

LONG JUMP BREAKING

- List and track results (collaboration for results)
- 3 Attempts Max to get the farthest score
- Must land of feet
- Single attempt then it goes to next competitor.
- Jump side kick is the technique use with max 12' running start (4 square mats)
- Touching the board for measuring does not constitute an attempt.
- In case of a Tie, the shorter competitor wins
- Judging Criteria: farthest score within 3 attempts

TEAM POWER BREAKING

- List and Track
- 3 individuals max on a team
- Only the foot can make contact to break
- Each team member must designate the number of boards to be attempted to judge prior to competition starting.
- Single attempt then it goes to next competitor.
- No changes to board designation allowed after declaration.
- The highest total sum of boards broken by each team member wins
- In case of Tie, lighter competitor wins or the competitor that attempted more
- Any side kick EXCEPT a flying side kick may be used (only one step)

TKD TIGER BREAKING

- Same as all other breaking events above
- Running breaking is a combo of high and long jump breaking over a small obstacle
- Tigers can choose a foot or hand technique for their break

 Judging Criteria: number of attempts, level of difficulty, number of stations, technique & balance
